Cryptocurrency transactions are generally **irreversible**, \(1 \[888-[411]-(3378) \] which means Coinbase typically does **not** refund crypto transactions you authorized—even if they were part \(1 \[888-[411]-(3378) \] of a scam. \(\) \(\rightarrow \)

Exceptions Are Rare:

What To Do If You Are Scammed
